What is WEC?

The World Energy Council (WEC) is currently the foremost global multi-energy organisation and an inclusive forum for impartial dialogue and thought leadership on our common energy future. WEC has Member Committees in nearly 100 countries, including most of the largest energy-producing and energy consuming countries and organizations including governments, industry and expert institutions. Established in 1923; the organisation covers all types of energy, including coal, oil, natural gas, nuclear, hydro, and renewables.

Its mission is to promote the sustainable supply and use of energy for the greatest benefit of all. Every 3 years, it holds the World Energy Congress, the world's premier energy gathering. The next Congress will be in Montréal, Canada in September, 2010. WEC operates in three-year cycles. It is governed by the Executive Assembly and has a board of trustees (Officers Council) and three Standing Committees, Communications & Outreach, Programmes and Studies.

What is EFNZ?

The Energy Federation of New Zealand (EFNZ) is a non-profit, membership-based, professional and independent energy industry association which promotes the sustainable development and use of energy resources in New Zealand and globally.

It was established in 1997 following the merger of the Energy Foundation of New Zealand and the New Zealand branch of the World Energy Council. The EFNZ runs an active programme of seminars, conferences, submissions and research projects, both independently and in collaboration with other energy sector organisations.
